



## Benefits to ComEx Preceptors

While ComEx preceptors are not paid faculty members, NUNM does provide benefits to practitioners who provide preceptorship opportunities to our students. We are appreciative of the time you dedicate to our students, and hope you will take advantage of the following:

- 12 (twelve) naturopathic Continuing Education hours of recorded video, found at [www.nunm.edu/ceonline](http://www.nunm.edu/ceonline). Just make an account, browse the table of contents, and send an e-mail to [ceregister@nunm.edu](mailto:ceregister@nunm.edu) with the list of courses you'd like to have unlocked on your account. This is a \$400 value! You may access this benefit annually, as long as you are an active ComEx preceptor (provide a preceptorship to at least one student per year for at least 12 hours).
- Library privileges – ComEx preceptors may receive a library card at the NUNM library which gives you access to over 16,000 books including the rare book room, CDs, DVDs, databases (**on-campus access only**) and computer applications in the library.
- The opportunity to learn new and updated information about the profession, keep abreast of the latest research, and educate future physicians by passing on invaluable knowledge.
- For NDs, the opportunity to give back to the profession as noted in the Naturopathic Physician's Oath and collaborate with the NDs of tomorrow.
