Final Graduation Review with Registrar & Diploma Information

- All documentation must be submitted to the Registrar's office by July 6th
- Students in clinical programs must request a transcript to go to their licensing board, request "after degree is posted."
- Diplomas will be printed with your legal name. If your name is/has changed, please provide legal proof to the Registrar's Office.
- Diplomas are mailed directly from the company and will arrive about July 27, mailed to address listed in SONIS (unless otherwise specified). Please make sure your information is updated in SONIS.
- Take multiple copies of your diploma before you frame it, you will need them.
- Students in clinical programs will need to send a copy of diploma to licensing board.
- **If you did not do a graduation review during the week of April 23 please contact the registrar office to make an appointment, required for all clinical degrees.**

Financial Aid and Exit Interview

- For July grads, each of you will receive an exit packet from Financial Aid by June 1st, to be completed by June 30th. The packet will have a detail of your borrowing history and information on the mandatory exit counseling. The exit counseling can be done online at www.studentloans.gov.
