STUDENT PARKING – LOTTERY APPLICATION & INFORMATION Spring 2022 Term

Due to our neighborhood location, NUNM does not have enough parking spaces to accommodate all students who wish to park on campus. We hold a lottery each year to allot student parking permits, with preference given to seniority and proven hardships. Students who do not receive a parking permit during the lottery process will be placed on a wait list and assigned parking permits as they become available. Parking enforcement and ticketing is not in effect during the first week of Fall term. Beginning the second week of classes, all vehicles parked on campus must display an NUNM parking permit or risk being ticketed.

• Parking Lottery Applications must be returned to the Safety & Security Office (Academic Building, Room 125) by 5 p.m., Friday, March 18, 2022.

- Lottery will take place Friday, March 25, 2022, and students will be billed accordingly.
- Passes will be placed in student mailboxes by Monday, March 28, 2022.

• Permitted students can park in any non-reserved white space. Do not park in the white/yellow spaces that are marked "RESERVED" or "VISITOR."

- The parking fee is \$107 each term.
- Payment is due to Student Accounts (Administration Building, Suite 200) no later than April 4, 2022.

• Daily permits may be purchased at the NUNM Bookstore (Academic Building, Room 115) for \$5. Make sure you plan in advance so that you have a permit available on the morning you need it. The NUNM Bookstore does not open until 9 a.m.

It's the first day of the term and I don't know where to park - help!

You may park in the lot ONLY if you have a hang-tag permit displayed on the rearview mirror in your car. All others will be subject to ticketing. Please do not park in reserved or visitor spaces.

How does NUNM know that I can park in the lot?

Your hang-tag permit must be placed on your rearview mirror, facing out, so it can be seen from the front of the car EVERY DAY. The hang-tag permit may be used on any car for which you provided information on your parking application. Carpoolers must switch the tag each day. Tickets will NOT be amended if you forget to hang your permit.

All spots are full – what do I do?

If you come to school and cannot find an empty student space, do NOT park in reserved or visitor spaces. You will have to find a space on the street for that day.

During what hours are student spaces restricted?

Student parking spaces are valid from 6 a.m. – 5 p.m., Monday through Friday year-round, unless otherwise instructed by the Director of Security. Evening and weekend parking in all non-reserved student spaces with white striping is open to all students, staff, and faculty. There is no overnight parking in the NUNM lots.

Can I park on the street?

The City of Portland WILL ticket cars parked longer than 2 hours. NUNM has no control over street parking regulation.

- Distance from NUNM (20-mile commute or greater)
- Inaccessibility to public transit and/or public transit trips that regularly take more than an hour
- Work or volunteering commitments
- Family obligations
